

Elin Pendleton's Color Boot Camp & Artists Retreat

Florida Carriage Museum & Resort in Weirsdale (Lady Lake), FL

Sunday May 2 - Friday May 7, 2010

Workshop Fee is \$450.

Accommodations for the week is \$300 per person for room & meals. Day students will pay \$50 for meals.

Workshop includes:

- Elin's Color Boot Camp
- five full days of art instruction with critiques, demonstrations and daily painting sessions from 9 – 4 each day
- A wine and cheese reception Sunday evening
- plein air painting opportunities (to watch or participate in) some evenings and early mornings
- photo opportunities of horses, dogs and hiking/walking the rolling landscape of Central Florida
- kitchen facilities for preparation of daily meals
- opportunity for dinner with the Group one evening at a casual local restaurant

Accommodations: We will be renting a lodge and a cottage. All buildings are non-smoking. The lodge sleeps 6 and has a large sunny glassed in porch where we will paint. The cottage sleeps 6 and has a barn attached. Bedrooms have some twin, and King size beds, and you will share a room with another artist. With the 2 units, we can accommodate women and men. We'll be doing our cooking at the lodge and the cost of the room includes groceries. There is a swimming pool and hot tub on the property. **If you stay at the resort, you will receive a pass to visit the on site Carriage Museum, and you will also receive a parking pass.** Day Students not staying at the resort will have to pay a \$15 per day Day Rate for use of the Resort and parking.

Please note: The seminar starts with a Welcome Party at 6:30 pm Sunday. The actual seminar is Monday through Friday. Your accommodations run from Sunday afternoon to Sunday morning so feel free to stay until Sunday morning and enjoy the beautiful resort and facilities.

Registration:

Class size is limited to 12 students (no exceptions) and reservations are accepted in the order in which they are received. A wait list will be created when the class is filled. Payment with Postmark or fax date/time determines ranking. Use the registration form provided to register for the workshop and use your choice of delivery/payment methods.

Please pay your \$100 deposit or the entire workshop fee (\$450), your accommodations fee of \$300 or Day Student Meals fee of \$50 with a check or money order made out to **Butterfly Kisses Studio**, with **Florida Boot Camp in the note section.**

Supplies and Equipment:

You will receive a supply list upon receipt of your registration. It is important that you bring everything needed for class since the workshop location is more than six miles from town. Bring your hiking boots/sneakers if you want to walk the facilities with Elin. There are tables and chairs for studio painting, but you will need your portable easels, either table or standing. Bring bug spray and hats or umbrella if you plan on outside painting. **(NOTE: If you wish to paint outdoors, you will need a folding stool, a field easel, clothing and shoes appropriate for working outdoors. Howeverm last year it was much too hot for outside painting, so we stayed in the A/C.)** If you are traveling in, supplies can be shipped via UPS, FEDEX or DHL to the Carriage Museum (see Travel Directions for shipping address).

Travel Directions:

The workshop will be held on the 400 acre Florida Carriage Museum & Resort, 3000 Marion County Road, Weirsdale (Lady Lake), FL 32195, telephone (352) 750-5500. The Orlando Intl. airport is approximately 65 miles from the resort, if you are flying into Orlando, please carpool or rent a car. Attendees flying in should arrive by early afternoon on the Sunday prior, to drive up (1.5 hours), get settled and attend the 6:30 PM welcoming party.

Cancellation Policy:

Deposits are applied as a pre-payment of tuition. All cancellations must be made in writing. Up to 30 days before the start of the workshop, \$75 cancellation fee will be retained for each cancellation. For cancellations with less than 30 days notice, the deposit of \$100 will be retained. Elin Pendleton Workshops cannot be responsible for issuing refunds, credits or transfers for classes missed due to illness, emergencies or events beyond our control.
